My topics of research are regional and local history in Colombia, comparative Latin American history; social and labour relations; agricultural studies on Colombian coffee production; independence; and settlement processes in the 19th and 20th centuries. In addition, I write on various aspects of historiography. I have published 31 articles, 23 book chapters, 6 books, 8 edited collections, and 8 reviews. Additionally, I've edited 9 volumes and 17 articles for the Journal *HiSTOReLo*, and published 29 articles in other formats.

I issued the call for the Symposium of Regional and Local History seven times and for the Colombian National History Congress twice.

Invited researcher at the University of Massachusetts - Amherst (United States), University of Goteborg (Sweden), Free University of Berlin (Germany) and Autonomous University of San Luis Potosi Mexico. Invited participant in seminars at the Universidad de Antioquia, Universidad del Valle, Universidad Industrial de Santander, Universidad del Atlántico, Universidad de Caldas, Universidad Tecnológica de Pereira, and the Universidad Nacional de Colombia, Bogota and the Universidad Nacional de Colombia, Manizales. Additionally, I have lectured on 71 occasions nationally and internationally.

In the field of teaching I have directed 5 history PhDs, 5 masters in history, 20 Professional historians and Professionals in political science, and supported 9 fellows of Colciencias' program.

I served as Dean of the Faculty of Human and Economic Sciences of the National University of Colombia, Medellín where I founded the the Doctorate program in Humanities and Social Sciences housed at both the National University of Colombia, Medellín and Bogotá; the Archivist Master program of the same university; and the Master program in History of the University of Antioquia.
